The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Fort Wingate Depot Activities (the Permittee) *Class 1 Permit Modification Request to Remove Parcels 4B, 5B, and 8 from the RCRA Permit*, dated December 11, 2008. The NMED has accepted the submittal for review. The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.F NMAC require the assessment of fees after receipt of an application for a permit modification. 
