I received the above referenced Notice of Violation (NOV) for Fort Wingate Depot Activity (FWDA) on May 23, 2006. The two violations cited in the NOV were resolved in the following manner:

Violation #1: Failure to maintain the contingency plan for the OB/OD Unit. The current contingency plan for the OB/OD unit was located at FWDA shortly after the departure of Ms. Anna Maestas and the other members of your staff on May 2, 2006, the day of the inspection. A message was left on Ms. Maestas' voicemail on the same day notifying her that the contingency plan had been located.

## Violation #2: Failure to amend the less than 90 day storage area contingency plan for the emergency coordinators.

The list of emergency coordinators in the contingency plan was made current on May 3, 2006.
