Dear Mr. Patterson:

Based on the discussions of the conference call held today between NMED, Fort Wingate Depot Activity, and PIKA personnel, and in response to the letter received today, November 7, 2007, NMED grants a modification to the *Emergency Permit of Onsite Treatment of Unstable Munitions and Explosives of Concern*, dated October 30, 2007.

NMED understands that the contents of the boxes stored in igloo B-1009 will be inspected, as planned, by a Senior UXO Supervisor and subdivided into smaller batches for destruction; however, the quantity of treated material allowed for each cycle will increase from 2 pounds Net Explosives Weight (NEW) to 6 pounds NEW.
