Attached is Figure 5-2, which is slightly modified from the original Figure 5-2 sent as an attachment to the Parcel 11 NOD dated December 23, 2008. Also, per our discussion at the meeting last week (10/14/2009), the Permittee may exclude the remaining sample locations as proposed in the Figure 5-3 of the revised Work Plan for Parcel 11 dated June 19, 2009. The Permittee must only sample at the locations shown on the attached figure 5-2, the only change is that the Permittee must collect soil samples at the water table from two locations (shown by the yellow dot) and include PCBs, TAL metals, and DRO extended in the analysis. You do not need to send a revision to the Work Plan, but please include this modification in the RFI Report for Parcel 11.

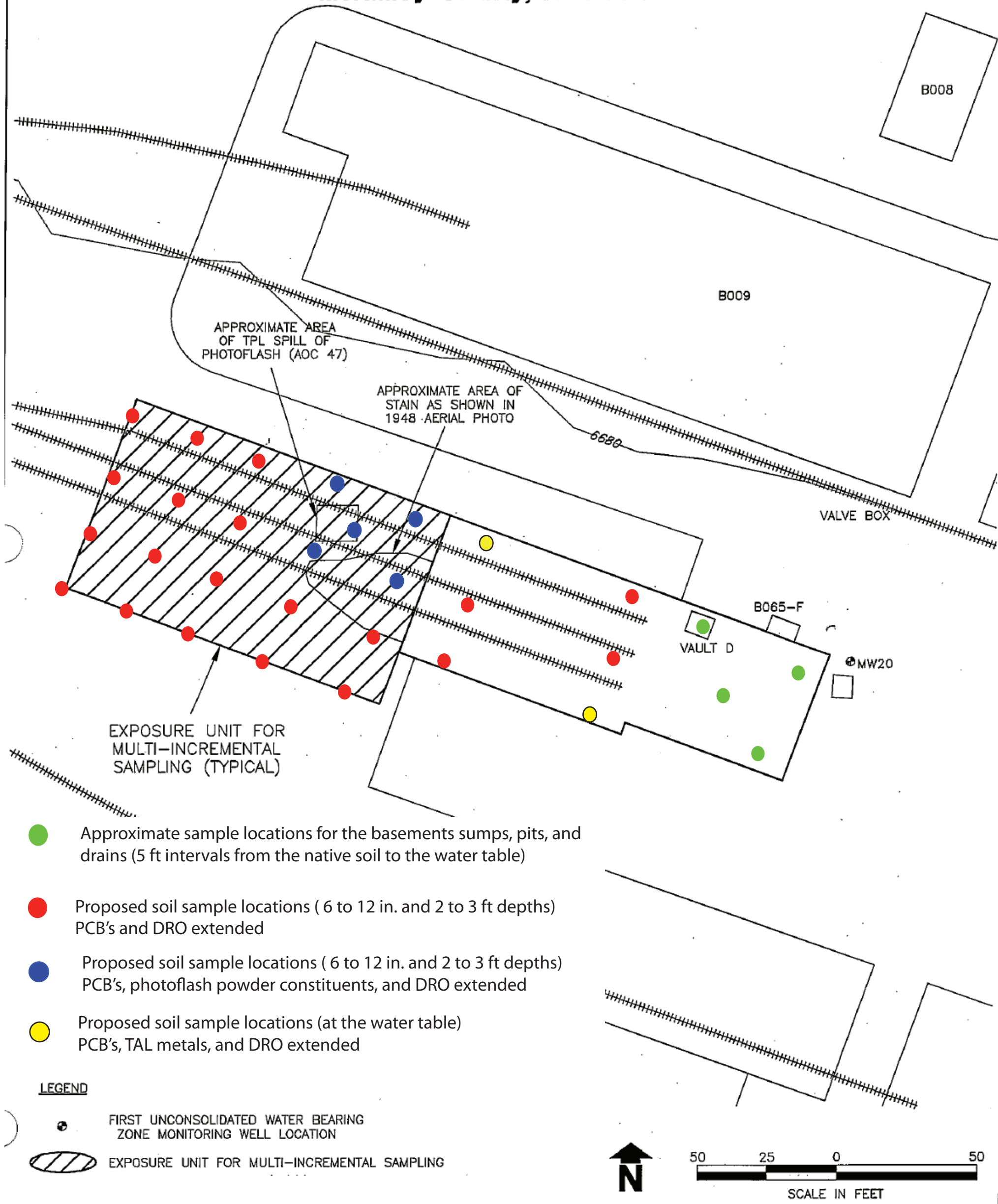
