Dear Mr. Wojciechowski:

On March 17, 1994, the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) received your request for a 60-day extension until May 24, 1994, for submitting an amendment to the Final Fort Wingate Depot Activity RCRA Interim Status Closure Plan. The extension is requested due to emergency administrative changes at the Army Environmental Center.

The HRMB grants the extension of time you requested to submit the amended closure plan for Fort Wingate Depot Activity. The due date is May 24, 1994. Please note that item 4 of the Conditions for Closure Plan Approval issued with the New Mexico Environment Department's (NMED) closure plan approval letter dated January 20, 1994, requires the amended plan to detail the requirements outlined in Section 3.3 and 3.4 of the approved closure plan.
