This letter is responding to an October 17, 1997, telephone conversation that was held with Mr. Dwayne Ford, Technical Manager, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District and Mr. Phillip Solano of my staff. In that conversation, Mr. Ford had asked if it would be possible to reference the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) document in the Post-Closure Care Plan (PCCP), to be submitted no later than November 15, 1997. Mr. Ford further stated that this would allow for a reduced duplication of effort in the development of the PCCP. The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) RCRA Permits Management Program's (RPMP) response to this request is that we will not accept or approve of the PCCP document submittal completed in such a manner. The PCCP is a RCRA stand-alone document.
