Per your request, attached is a letter of designation signed by the Lt. Governor, Willard Zunie based on the Governor's concurrence on Ft. Wingate activities when both you and the Governor were in Washington, DC last month. This letter was necessary since the Army Corp of Engineers and New Mexico Department of Environment required the letter of designation before they would talk to me on behalf of the Zuni Pueblo. This is the only document prepared on my behalf and accepted by both entities.
