The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received Fort Wingate Depot Activity's (Permittee's) RCRA Facility Work Plan, Parcel 13 dated May 10, 2012 (Plan). NMED reviewed the Plan and hereby issues this Approval with the following Modifications.

Modifications:

- 1. The NMED Soil Screening Levels (SSLs) were revised in February 2012. Where appropriate, use the updated SSLs as applicable taking care to use the most recent EPA Regional Screening Levels (RSLs) in cases where SSLs are unavailable for preparation of the Investigation Report.
- 2. The Plan indicates oil and grease was reported present at 750 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) in the sediment sample collected from Area of Concern (AOC) 53 in 1981. Add oil range organics (ORO, EPA Method 8015B) analyses for each of the 10 discrete sediment samples proposed for collection. In the event the location of the 1981 sediment sample is known or can be determined, move one of the five proposed discrete sediment sample locations to the 1981 location.
