In partial satisfaction of our requirements under the 1991 Memorandum of Agreement between the US Army and the New Mexico State Historic Preservation Office, the US Army has had a Traditional Cultural Properties inventory completed for the Fort Wingate Activity Depot, McKinley County, New Mexico. The Army had a standalone survey report completed to represent the Zuni Pueblo cultural perspective and one to represent the Navajo Nation's point of view.
