Dear Messrs. Patterson and Smith:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received Fort Wingate Depot Activity's (the Permittee) letter requesting an extension of time for the submittal of the Parcel 18, Eastern Landfill Investigation and Remediation report (Report), dated April 9, 2014.

The original submittal date was March 3, 2014; the Permittee is requesting an extension to submit the report by December 15, 2014. Section I.M (Provisions Governing Extensions of Time) of the Permit states that "the Permittee may seek an extension of time in which to perform a requirement of this Permit, for good cause..." The Permittee states that they are "seeking an extension in time under Permit section I.M due to additional time needed to sample and test monitor wells, to prepare the Report, and allow for the Tribal review and comment incorporation." NMED hereby grants the extension request. The Report must be submitted to NMED by **December 15, 2014**.
