The AN-M66A2, which contains 1.179 pounds of the explosive Tritonal 180 percent TNT and 20 percent aluminum powder, will be disposed of by controlled denoration. The disposal will occur within an Army-owned purcel and PWDA. Military-minde Unserploade Orthanace Technicians will handle the bomb and complete the disposal process. Approved engineering controls will be employed to reduce the last and fragmentation military from the disposal process. Approved engineering controls will be employed Bartfendos will be placed at necess points at a distance of at least 1.319 feet from the disposal area and so unauthorized persons will likely notice noise (i.e. explosion) and dust/moke during the disposal process.

NMED has determined that this authorization is necessary to safely dispose of the bomb (a form of hazardous waste) in order to prevent or mitigate an energypacy. The emergency authorization was issued because the RCRA permit does not allow for disposal of more than 200 pounds of explosive waste at once.

The detonation is planned for May 20, 2015, Alternate dotes for the detonation are May 21, May 27, and May 28, 2015.
