RE: REVIEW OF ON-SITE INVESTIGATION AT THE FT. WINGATE DEPOT ACTIVITY ADMINISTRATION AREA, GALLUP, NEW MEXICO

Dear Mr. Gamel:

On April 13, 1995 the New Mexico Environment Department sent a letter requesting a hydrogeologic investigation at the abovereferenced site. Since that time the Department has reviewed the latest water sampling lab results. These results indicate that all water contamination is below state action levels. Therefore, the Department retracts it's request for a hydrogeologic investigation.

The Department is, however, requiring two years of continuous quarterly sampling of the impacted aquifer starting next quarter. These samples should be taken in all monitoring wells on this site when water is present and analysed by EPA Method 8310. The Department requires that a workplan for this monitoring be submitted to the Department for approval as soon as possible.
