Army says Patriot missile test a success

Missile test

FORT WINGATE — Preliminary test data shows the Juno missile launched from the Fort Wingate Army base Thursday was successfully intercepted and destroyed by a Patriot missile at the White Sands Missile Range.

According to a news release issued by White Sands, the Juno target was intercepted Thursday at 6:58 a.m. by a Patriot Advanced Capability Three, using the weapon system's radar track data to detect and engage the target.

The test was conducted to “demonstrate the capability of the Patriot system, using PDB-8 to detect, track, engage and kill a threatrep-

representative TBM with PAC-3 MSE Missiles,” according to the news release.
