Dear Messrs. Patterson and Smith:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed for administrative completeness the Fort Wingate Depot Activity (FWDA) Draft Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Permit Renewal Application (Application) dated June 25, 2015, as required under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations 20.4.1.900 NMAC. The Application is for the renewal of the Permit to close the Open Burn/Open Detonation (OB/OD) Hazardous Waste Management Unit and for operation of a Corrective Action Management Unit (CAMU) that was added to the original Permit on June 27, 2011.

After reviewing the permit application and related documents, NMED has determined the subject application to be administratively complete.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20.4.2 NMAC require assessment of fees when administrative review of a document is complete. NMED will issue an invoice to you under a separate cover. Payment of the fees is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice. Upon receipt of payment, the NMED will conduct a review of the Application and prepare a draft Permit renewal.

Should FWDA need to request an extension of the sixty-day period, the request must be received by NMED a minimum of fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the end of the sixty-day period. Should the Permit Applicant disagree with the fee assessed, you may file an Administrative Appeal under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.1.NMAC. Upon receipt of the fee, NMED will issue the draft Post-Closure Care Permit for comments.
