Dear Messrs. Patterson and Smith:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed for administrative completeness the Fort Wingate Depot Activity (FWDA) Petition for a Corrective Action Complete determination for Areas of Concern (AOCs) 29 and 75 and removal of Parcel 4A from within the Facility Boundary dated September 2, 2015 and received on September 8, 2015. The petition is considered to be a Class 3 Permit Modification Request (PMR) and is subject to the requirements of 20.4.1.900 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR 270.42).

After reviewing the PMR, NMED has determined the subject application to be administratively complete. The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC require the assessment of fees after an application is deemed administratively complete. The fee invoice is attached to this letter. Upon receipt of payment, NMED will initiate a technical review of the submittal in accordance with 20.4.2.201.B (3) NMAC.

Should FWDA need to request an extension of the sixty-day period, the request must be received by NMED a minimum of fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the end of the sixty-day period.


