The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received the *Final Groundwater Periodic Monitoring Report, July through December 2014* (Report), dated April 1, 2015 from Fort Wingate Depot Activity (FWDA). The NMED has accepted the submittal for review in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Order and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC.
